- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles
- Tubes 3, 18 and 233
- Serving plate
- One cake mix or ingredients for your favorite scratch cake
- 3½ cups buttercream icing (recipe in this booklet) or three packages of creamy vanilla type frosting mix (15.4 oz. box)
- Wilton Paste Food Colors in Violet, Red-Red, Golden Yellow and Brown
- Art brush

THE COUNT CAKE

To make The Count, you will need Wilton Paste Food Colors in Violet, Red-Red, Golden Yellow and Brown. We suggest you color all the icings at one time, while the cake is cooling.

- Tint 1 cup violet for The Count's face
- Tint 123 cups brown for his cape, hair and facial features
- Tint ¼ cup red for his tongue and ribbon
- Tint ¼ cup yellow for his ribbon
- Reserve 1/3 cup white for his shirt, eyes and teeth

WITH-WHITE ICING

- Use tube 18 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover The Count's shirt with stars.
- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill-in the whites of his eyes and his teeth.

WITH RED ICING

- Use tube 18 and "To Make Stars" directions to make the stripes of his ribbon.
- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill-in his tongue.

WITH YELLOW ICING

Use tube 18 and "To Make Stars" directions to add stripe to his ribbon

WITH VIOLET ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill-in The Count's eyelids and under eyes.
- Use tube 18 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover The Count's face with stars.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill-in the pupils of his eyes.
- Use tube 18 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover his cape, hair, eyebrows and inside of mouth with stars.
- Use tube 233 and "To Make Count's Beard" directions to add his beard
