

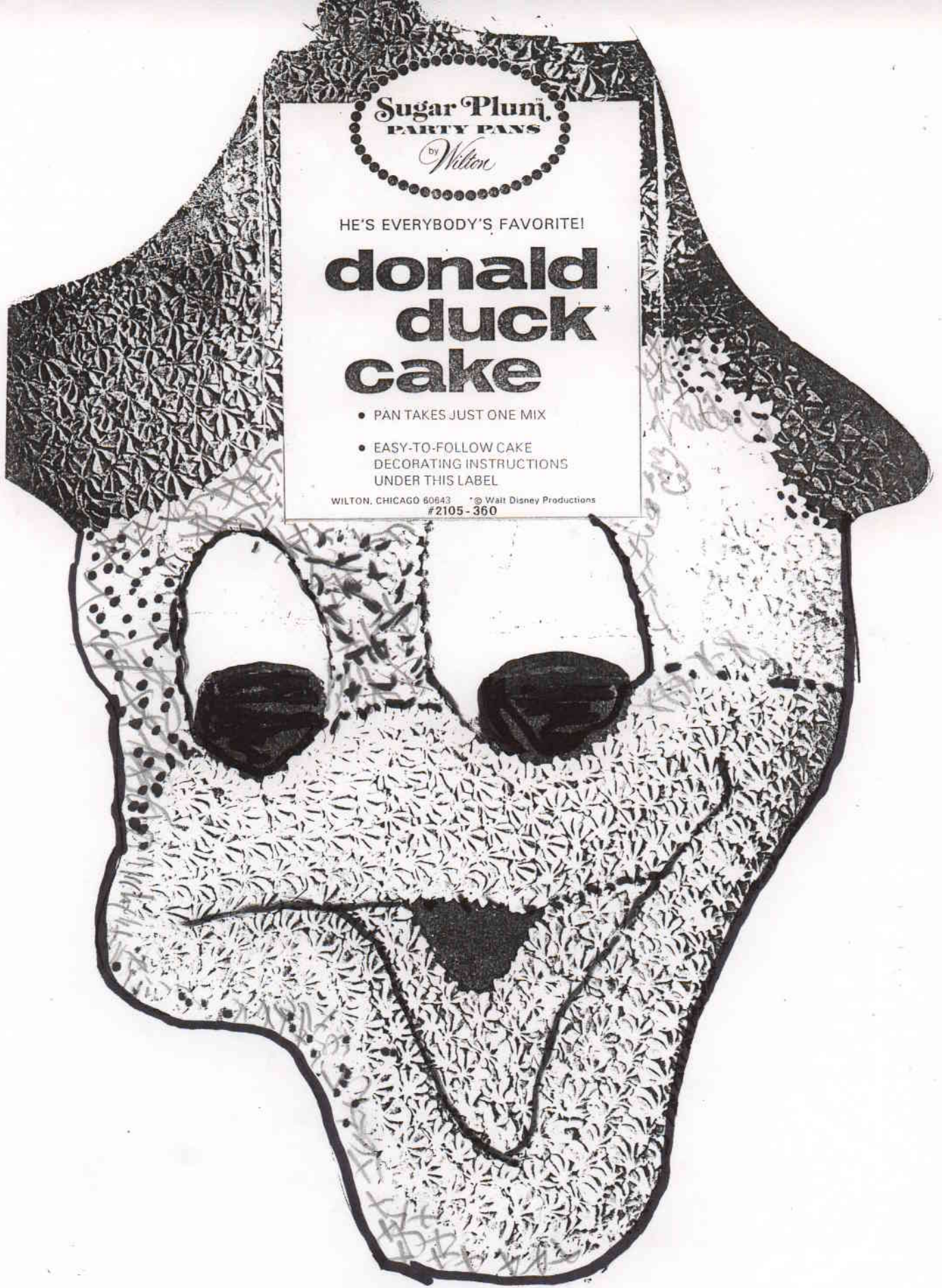

Donald Duck Cake



PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE
BEFORE YOU BEGIN, you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and coupler or parchment paper triangles
- Tubes 3 and 21
- Wilton Cake Board or serving plate large enough to hold cake
- One cake mix or ingredients for your favorite scratch recipe
- 3½ cups buttercream icing (recipe inside this booklet) or three packages of frosting mix (creamy vanilla type, 15.4 oz. box)
- Wilton Paste Food Colors: Sky Blue, Golden Yellow, Brown, Red-Red.
- A small art brush



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Decorating your DONALD DUCK CAKE

To make the Donald Duck cake in the colors shown, you will need Wilton Paste Food Colors in Sky Blue, Golden Yellow, Brown and Red-Red. We suggest you color all icings at one time, while the cake is cooling.

- Tint 1 cup yellow for Donald's duck bill.
- Tint $\frac{3}{4}$ cup blue for Donald's hat.
- Tint $\frac{3}{4}$ cup brown for Donald's hat ribbon and for outlining Donald's eyes, pupils, hat and duck bill.
- Tint $\frac{1}{4}$ cup red for Donald's tongue.
- Reserve $\frac{3}{4}$ cup white for Donald's face and whites of eyes.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline" directions to outline Donald's hat and hat ribbon, eyes, pupils and duck bill.
- Use tube 21 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover Donald's hat ribbon with stars.
- Thin remaining brown icing with $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon milk. The use tube 3 and "To Make Donald's Eyes" directions to fill in pupils of eyes.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tube 21 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover Donald's face with stars.
- Thin remaining white icing with $\frac{1}{4}$ teaspoon milk and use tube 3 and "To Make Donald's Eyes" directions once again to fill in whites of eyes.

WITH RED ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline" directions to outline Donald's tongue.
- Thin remaining red icing with a few drops milk and use tube 3 and "To Make Donald's Tongue" directions to fill in tongue area.

WITH YELLOW ICING

- Use tube 21 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover Donald's duck bill with icing stars.

WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tube 21 and "To Make Stars" directions once again to cover Donald's hat with stars.

HINT: For a bright finishing touch to Donald, brush a thin coating of corn syrup on eyes, pupils and tongue area after they've dried.
