Design shown uses tubes 3 and 16.

Decorating Your Donald Duck Character Cake

To make the Donald Duck cake in the colors shown, you will need Red-Red, Royal Blue, Golden Yellow, Lemon Yellow and Brown. We suggest you color all icings at one time while the cake cools. Refrigerate colored icings in covered containers until ready to use.

- Tint ½ cup icing blue for Donald Duck's sailor hat and shirt.
- Tint ½ cup icing red for his sailor bow and gift bow.
- Tint ½ cup icing pink for gift package. (Add very small amount of Red-Red to white icing. Thin with 1 Tablespoon corn syrup or 1 teaspoon milk.)
- Tint ¼ cup lemon yellow for his shirt stripes.
- Tint ½ cup icing brown for outlines, eyes, gift bow, background area, hat ribbon message.
- Reserve ½ cup white icing for his feathers.
- Tint ¼ cup icing light blue for his eyes. (Add very small amount of Royal Blue to white icing.)
- Tint ½ cup icing golden yellow for his bill and leg.

WITH PINK ICING

- Use a spatula to ice gift package smooth.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline" directions to outline Donald Duck's features, clothes and gift package details.
- Use tube 3 and "To Print" directions to add message to gift package.
- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill in his pupils.
- Use tube 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover hat ribbon and inside of ribbon with stars.

WITH LIGHT BLUE ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill in his eyes.

WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tube 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover his hat and shirt with stars.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his feathers and hand with stars.

WITH GOLDEN YELLOW ICING

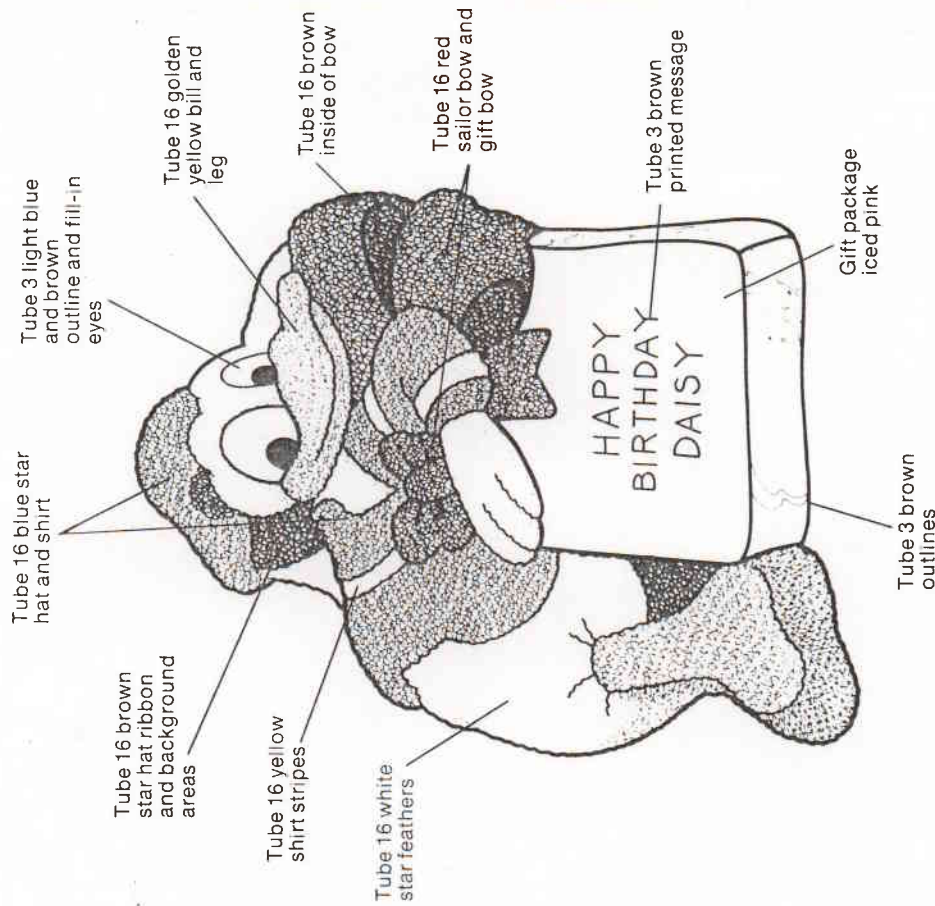
- Use tube 16 to cover his bill and leg with stars.

WITH YELLOW ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his shirt stripes with stars.

WITH RED ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his sailor bow and gift bow with stars.

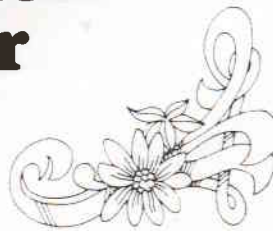




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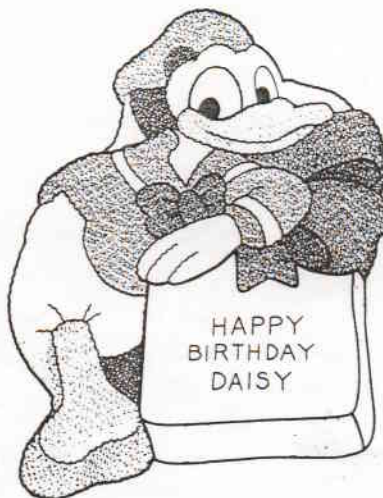

PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE.
TO DECORATE CAKE you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles
- Tubes 3 and 16
- Serving plate
- One cake mix or ingredients to make your favorite layer cake recipe
- 3½ cups buttercream icing (recipe in this booklet) or 3 packages of creamy vanilla type frosting mix (15.4 oz. box)
- Wilton Paste Food Colors: Red-Red, Royal Blue, Golden Yellow, Lemon Yellow and Brown
- Spatula

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To make the Donald Duck cake in the colors shown, you will need Red-Red, Royal Blue, Golden Yellow, Lemon Yellow and Brown. We suggest you color all icings at one time while the cake cools. Refrigerate colored icings in covered containers until ready to use.

- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup icing blue for Donald Duck's sailor hat and shirt.
- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup icing red for his sailor bow and gift bow.
- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup icing pink for gift package. (Add very small amount of Red-Red to white icing. Thin with 1 Tablespoon corn syrup or 1 teaspoon milk.)
- Tint $\frac{1}{4}$ cup lemon yellow for his shirt stripes.
- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup icing brown for outlines, eyes, gift bow, background area, hat ribbon message.
- Reserve $\frac{1}{2}$ cup white icing for his feathers.
- Tint $\frac{1}{4}$ cup icing light blue for his eyes. (Add very small amount of Royal Blue to white icing.)
- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup icing golden yellow for his bill and leg.

WITH PINK ICING

- Use a spatula to ice gift package smooth.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline" directions to outline Donald Duck's features, clothes and gift package details.
- Use tube 3 and "To Print" directions to add message to gift package.
- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill in his pupils.
- Use tube 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover hat ribbon and inside of ribbon with stars.

WITH LIGHT BLUE ICING

- Use tube 3 and "To Outline and Fill-In" directions to fill in his eyes.

WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tube 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover his hat and shirt with stars.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his feathers and hand with stars.

WITH GOLDEN YELLOW ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his bill and leg with stars.

WITH YELLOW ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his shirt stripes with stars.

WITH RED ICING

- Use tube 16 to cover his sailor bow and gift bow with stars.
