▲ Little Train (Feature)

Use tips 3, 16, 21 and Wilton Icing Colors in Lemon Yellow, Sky Blue, Christmas Red and Brown. Red dot candies, licorice stick and gumdrop are also needed.



▲ Sweetheart Express

Use tips 3, 7, 21 and Wilton Icing Colors in Pink and Violet.



▲ "Clownmutter" Train

Use tips 3, 16, 21 and Wilton Icing Colors in Golden Yellow, Brown and Orange. Small Derby Clowns (stock no. 2113-2759) and candy-coated chocolates are also needed.



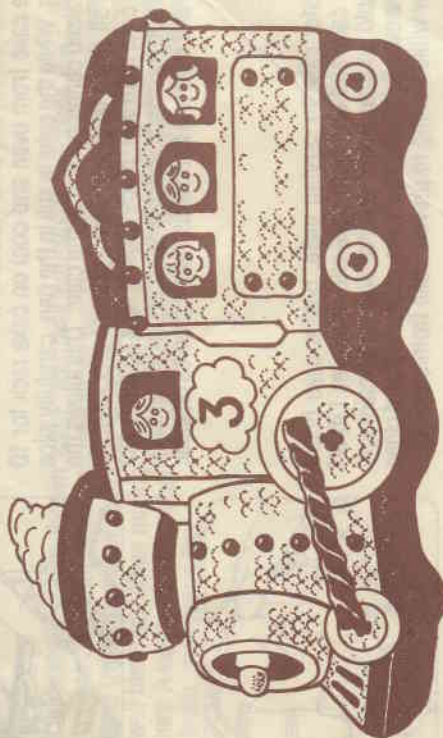
Instruction Guide for Baking & Decorating

Little Train Cakes

PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE.

TO DECORATE CAKES you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag & Coupler or parchment paper triangles.
- Tips 3, 16, 21 (alternate also uses tip 7).
- Wilton Icing Colors in Brown, Sky Blue, Lemon Yellow, Christmas Red (alternate designs use Pink, Violet, Orange, Golden Yellow and Brown).
- One 2-layer cake mix or ingredients for favorite layer cake recipe.
- Buttercream icing (recipe inside).
- Red dot candies, candy wafers and licorice stick for feature design; candy-coated chocolates and Small Derby Clowns (stock no. 2113-2759) for alternate design.

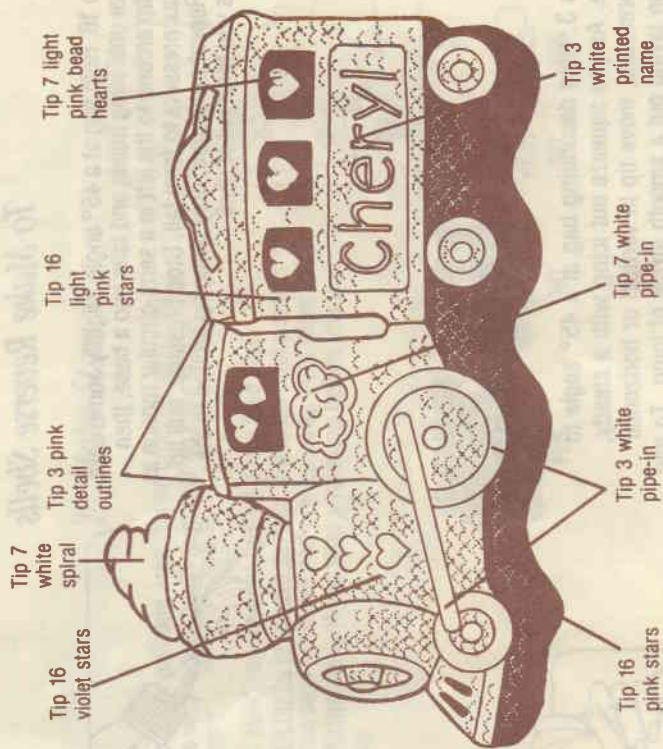


To Decorate Sweetheart Express Cake

You will need Pink and Violet Icing Colors; tips 3, 7 and 21.

Make 4 cups of buttercream icing:

- Tint 1 1/4 cups light pink.
- Tint 1 cup pink (thin 1/4 cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Tint 1 1/4 cups violet.
- Reserve 1/2 cup white.

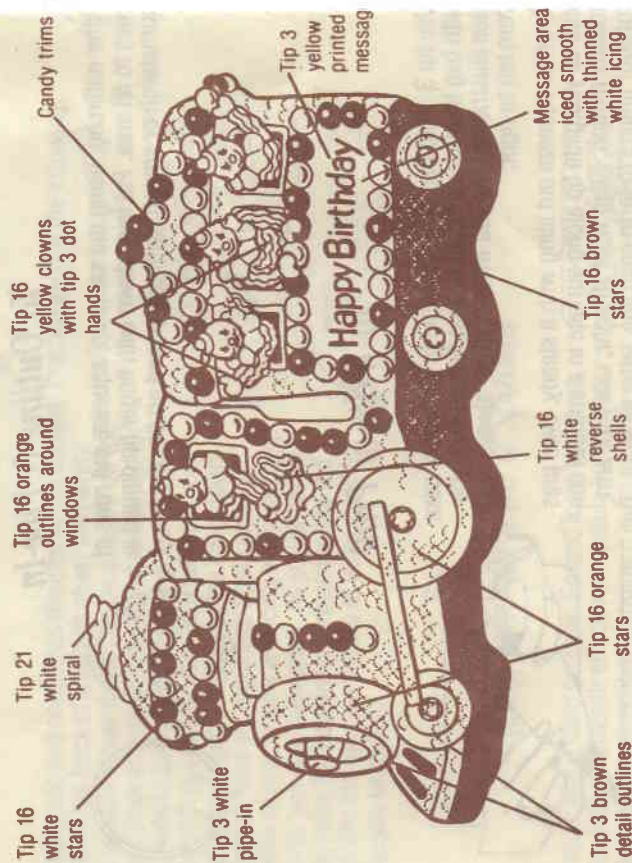


To Decorate "Clownmutter" Train Cake

You will need Golden Yellow, Brown, Orange Icing Colors; tips 3 and 16; Small Derby Clowns; candy-coated chocolates.

Make 4 cups of buttercream icing:

- Tint 1/2 cup yellow.
- Tint 1 1/4 cups orange.
- Tint 3/4 cup brown (thin 1/4 cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Reserve 1 1/2 cups white (thin 1/4 cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).



To Decorate Little Train Cake

You will need Wilton Icing Colors in Brown, Lemon Yellow, Sky Blue, Christmas Red; tips 3, 16 and 21. We suggest that you tint all icings at one time while cake cools. Refrigerate tinted icings in covered containers until ready to use. You will also need red dot candies, wafer candy, gumdrop and licorice stick.

Make $4\frac{1}{4}$ cups buttercream icing:

- Tint $1\frac{1}{4}$ cups yellow.
- Tint $1\frac{1}{4}$ cups blue.
- Tint $\frac{1}{2}$ cup red.
- Tint $\frac{1}{4}$ cup light brown.

WITH RED ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover bands of smokestack, roof of cab and car, row of stars on engine and spokes of wheels.

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Zigzags" directions to cover bottom of cowcatcher.

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to pipe smiles on candy faces.
- Use tip 16 and "To Make Outlines" directions to add number.

WITH LIGHT BROWN ICING

- Position candy disc faces. Use tip 3 and "To Make Hair" directions to pipe different hair styles on candy.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in background area between smokestack, cab and car, trim on front of engine, wheel rims and puff of smoke (overpipe to add dimension).

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 21 and "To Make Spirals" directions to pipe smoke.
- Add red dot candy trims, gumdrop headlight and licorice brake shaft.

- Tint $\frac{3}{4}$ cup brown (thin $\frac{1}{4}$ cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Reserve $\frac{1}{4}$ cup white icing.

WITH THINNED BROWN ICING

- With a spatula, ice windows, center front of engine and opening of cowcatcher smooth.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline engine's windows, smokestack, cab, engine, cowcatcher, brake shaft, wheels, puff of smoke; train car's roof, windows, side and wheels.

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover bottom side of engine and car.

WITH YELLOW ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover center of smokestack, trim on roof of cab, side of engine, top portion of cowcatcher, wheels, trim of roof of car and side panel.

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline front of engine.

WITH BLUE ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover remaining panel on engine, cab and side of car.
- Use tip 3 and "To Make Dots" directions to pipe eyes on candy faces.
