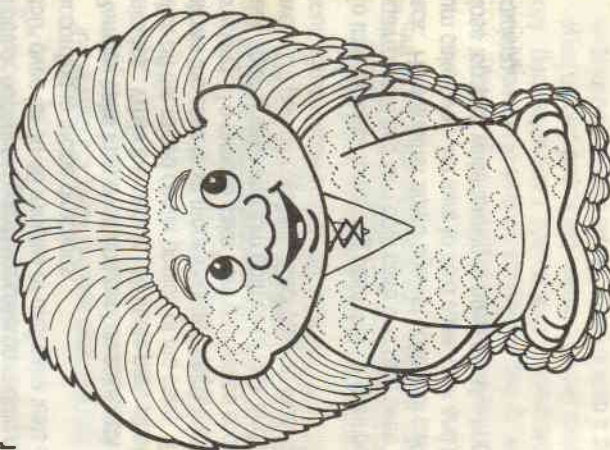


Instructions for Baking & Decorating *Troll Cake*

PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE

TO DECORATE CAKES you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles.
- Tips 3, 16 (alternate ideas also use tips 4 and 17).
- Wilton Icing Colors in Moss Green, Orange, Copper and Brown (alternate ideas also use Pink, Royal Blue, Lemon Yellow and Teal).
- One 2-layer cake mix or ingredients for favorite layer cake recipe.
- Buttercream Icing (recipe inside).
- "Take-A-Swim" design also uses two candy-coated chocolate dot candies.

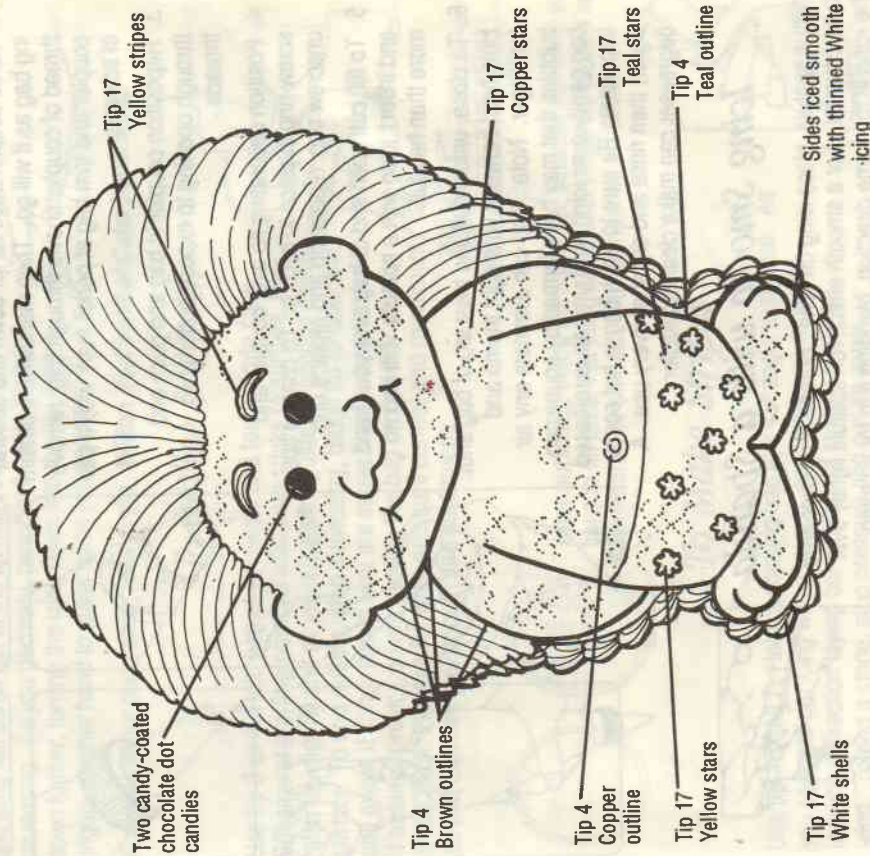


How To Decorate Take-A-Swim Troll

You will need Wilton Icing Colors in Brown, Copper, Lemon Yellow and Teal; tips 4 and 17; two candy-coated chocolate dot candies.

Make 4 cups buttercream icing:

- Tint 1 cup copper.
- Tint 1 1/2 cups lemon yellow.
- Tint 1/4 cup teal.
- Tint 1/4 cup brown (thin with 1/2 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Reserve 1 cup white (thin 1/2 cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).

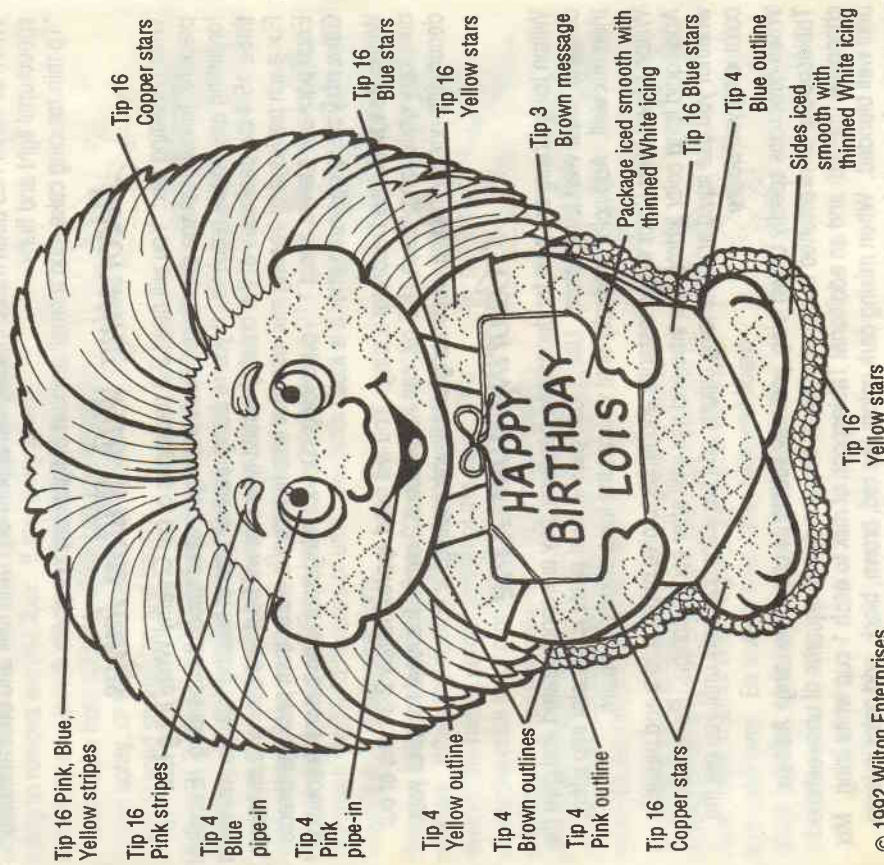


How To Decorate Gifted Troll

You will need Wilton Icing Colors in Pink, Copper Brown, Royal Blue and Lemon Yellow; and tips 3, 4 and 16.

Make 4 cups buttercream icing:

- Tint 3/4 cup pink.
- Tint 1/2 cup copper.
- Tint 1/4 cup brown (thin with 1/2 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Tint 1 cup royal blue.
- Tint 1 cup lemon yellow.
- Reserve 1/2 cup white (thin with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).



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How To Decorate Troll Cake

You will need Wilton Icing Colors in Moss Green, Orange, Copper and Brown; tips 3 and 16. We suggest that you tint all icings at one time while cake cools. Refrigerate icings in covered containers until ready to use.

Make 4 cups buttercream icing:

- Tint 1/2 cup light green.
- Tint 1/4 cup dark green.
- Tint 1 1/2 cups orange.
- Tint 1/2 cup light copper.
- Tint 1/4 cup brown (thin with 1/2 teaspoon light corn syrup).
- Reserve 1 cup white (thin 1/2 cup with 1 teaspoon light corn syrup).

WITH THINNED WHITE ICING

- With spatula, ice background area on cake sides smooth.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline feet, arms, head, eyes, mouth, nose and chin.
- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in mouth.

WITH DARK GREEN ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Make Outlines" directions to outline shirt.
- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in v-neck and hem.

WITH LIGHT GREEN ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to cover shirt.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in eyes and teeth.

WITH LIGHT COPPER ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stars" directions to fill in feet, arms, chest and face. Add another layer of tip 16 stars for built-up area above eyes.

WITH BROWN ICING

- Use tip 3 and "To Pipe-In" directions to fill in eyes.
- Use tip 3 and add outlines for ties at shirt neck.

WITH ORANGE ICING

- Use tip 16 and "To Make Stripes" directions to add hair and eyebrows.

WITH WHITE ICING

- Use tip 16 and add shell border to base.
