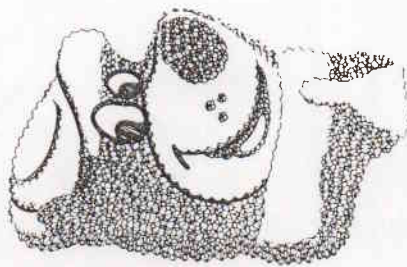

PLEASE READ THROUGH INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE YOU DECORATE

BEFORE YOU BEGIN, you will need:

- Wilton Decorating Bag and Coupler or parchment paper triangles
- Writing tube 3 and star tube 16
- Wilton Cake Board, 13" x 19", cookie sheet or serving plate large enough to hold pan
- One cake mix or ingredients for your favorite scratch recipe
- Two packages of frosting mix (creamy vanilla type, 15.4 oz. box), or ingredients to make one recipe of buttercream icing from recipe given in this booklet
- Wilton Paste Food Color in Brown, Leaf Green and Red-Red
- A small art brush



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# Decorating Your YOGI BEAR CAKE

To make the Yogi Bear cake in the colors shown, you will need Wilton Paste Food Colors in Brown, Leaf Green and Red-Red. We suggest you color all icings at one time, while cake is cooling. Refrigerate colored icings in covered containers until ready to use.

- Tint ½ cup of icing beige for covering Yogi's lower face, his ears and neck.
- Tint 1 cup icing light brown for covering the rest of Yogi's face, his ears and neck.
- Tint ½ cup icing dark brown for outlining Yogi's features, his hat, collar and tie and for forming his hat band, his nose, the inside of his mouth and his freckles. When finished with all these areas, squeeze out icing left in bag, thin with ¼ teaspoon water and replace in bag for filling in pupils of Yogi's eyes.
- Tint 1 cup icing green for covering Yogi's hat and tie.
- Reserve ½ cup icing white for covering Yogi's collar. When finished with collar, squeeze out icing left in bag, thin with ¼ teaspoon water for filling in whites of Yogi's eyes. Squeeze out thinned icing left in bag to tint for Yogi's tongue.
- Tint leftover thinned white icing a bright red for filling in Yogi's tongue. (Wash and dry bag thoroughly before putting in red.)

## WITH DARK BROWN ICING

- Using tube 3, outline all features and details on Yogi Bear: hat, hatband, eyes and pupils, lower face, nose, mouth, tongue, collar and tie, using technique given in "To Outline" above. The lines will serve as a guide when you begin decorating with stars.

## WITH BEIGE ICING

- With tube 16, fill in Yogi's lower face with stars, as directed in "To Make Stars" above. Start on top surface of cake and fill in one small area at a time. Follow contours of cake by making stars along guide-lines (don't cover them). Turn cake so part you are decorating always faces you. HINT: if stars begin losing their shape, the icing has become soft from the warmth of your hand. Take a ten minute break and put decorating bag into refrigerator.

## WITH LIGHT BROWN ICING

- With tube 16, fill in the rest of Yogi's head, his ears and neck, with stars, using same technique as for lower face.

## WITH WHITE ICING

- With tube 16, fill in Yogi's collar with stars, using same technique as for Yogi's head.
- With remainder of white icing thinned and replaced in decorating bag, fill in the whites of Yogi's eyes, following directions in "To Make Yogi's Eyes and Tongue" above.

## WITH GREEN ICING

- With tube 16, cover Yogi's hat and tie with stars, using same technique as for his head and face.

## WITH DARK BROWN ICING

- With tube 16, cover Yogi's nose, inside mouth and hat band with stars. Squeeze out three stars on his lower face for freckles.
- With remaining dark brown icing thinned and replaced in decorating bag, fill in the pupils of Yogi's eyes, following directions in "To Make Yogi's Eyes and Tongue" above.

Your Yogi Bear cake is ready to serve. And when the children see it on the party table, they'll shout: "Hey there, it's Yogi Bear!"
